Minnesota, does hereby ordain as follows:


1. Lands described as Lots 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, Lauer-

hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Olivia.


2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies

Thomas Dutcher, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Olivia Times-Journal and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Olivia in the County of Renville and it has its known office of issue in the Village of Olivia in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance No. 157

hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for successive weeks; that it was first so published on Wed. the 16 day of June 1976 and was thereafter printed and published on every to and including the day of
