ORDINANCE NO. 157

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LANDS TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OLIVIA

The City Council of the City of Olivia, Renville County, Minnesota, does hereby ordain as follows:

- 1. Lands Jescribed as Lots 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, Lauerman's Gateway Subdivision; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, Lauerman's Second Gateway Subdivision; and all that parcel of land in Section 11, Township 115, Range 35, bounded on the East by the East line of said Section 11, on the South by the South line of said Section 11, on the West by the North/South Quarter line of said Section 11, and on the North by the right-of-way of Trunk Highway U.S. 212, are hereby annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Olivia.
- 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the appropriate offices of the Minnesota Municipal Commission, Secretary of State and the County Auditor.
- 3. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication and filing thereof as provided by law.
