NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

September 25 - October 1, 1977 as

CLEAN-UP WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to make a special effort to beautify their surroundings and to recognize that a clean environment is a healthy environment.

FURTHERMORE, I urge all citizens to use the resources of the Governor's Aesthetic Environment Program which coordinates the work of those state agencies having programs concerned with-fighting visual pollution.
