

Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Henry M. Wrobleski, Captain of Police Operations, Edina Police Department, was born in North Minneapolis, the son of Polish immigrants; and
- WHEREAS: he joined the Edina Police Department in 1947, and for 22 years of his 30-year career as a police officer, served in a supervisory and management capacity; and
- WHEREAS: to further his professional career, Captain Wrobleski availed himself of a number of law enforcement courses, attended the FBI Academy and earned a law degree from LaSalle University in 1975; and
- WHEREAS: Captain Wrobleski has been the innovator of many police programs, he has developed 27 police training films on search and seizure under a grant from the Governor's Crime Control Planning Board, and is the author of two books on law enforcement; and
- WHEREAS: he was a lecturer at the University of Minnesota for three years and has been an instructor at Normandale Community College since 1972; and
- WHEREAS: Captain Wrobleski serves as an advisor on Senator Winston Borden's Legislative Committee on Organized Crime and Law Enforcement and has served in an advisory capacity on a number of committees, including management and business organizations; and
- WHEREAS: in 1971, his lobbying efforts succeeded in killing a bill which would have legalized pari-mutuel betting in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: he is a Veteran of World War II, having served 34 months overseas in the South Pacific area with the United States Marine Corps, 1st Division; and
- WHEREAS: in 1975, Captain Wrobleski was selected for the annual community service award by the Edina Optimist Club; and
- WHEREAS: the Edina Chamber of Commerce and the Edina Independent Police Association are sponsoring a "Hank Wrobleski Appreciation Dinner" on September 30;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, September 30, 1977 to be


