WHEREAS: the Women's Conference has recognized the need for, and initiated a National

Crusade to have Safety On the Streets; and

WHEREAS: the Safety On the Streets Crusade represents an action-oriented program for

volunteers nationwide, who marshal the human resources of their communities and public service, civic, fraternal, and law enforcement agencies to have

safe neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS: program aspects of S.O.S. include automobile, bicycle, pedestrian, personal,

and school safety, with public support being urged for alcohol and drug counter-measures, improved street lighting, and national highway safety standards;

SAFETY ON THE STREETS WEEK
