WHEREAS: *the Women's Conference of the National Safety Council, and the women of the Minnesota Safety Council, represent some 60 members at large and 61 national and international women's organizations with an outreach to 55 million women; and*

WHEREAS: *the Women's Conference has recognized the need for, and initiated a National Crusade to have Safety On the Streets; and*

WHEREAS: *the Safety On the Streets Crusade represents an action-oriented program for volunteers nationwide, who marshal the human resources of their communities and public service, civic, fraternal, and law enforcement agencies to have safe neighborhoods; and*




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the last week of October as


