WHEREAS: Registered Nurses have demonstrated by their knowledge, skills, and understanding that they are deeply committed to the overall health of each individual; and

WHEREAS: the Registered Nurses of Minnesota have always been among the leaders of their profession in seeking out methods to improve patient care;
