



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the United Way campaign is now in progress and will continue through October 28; and*

WHEREAS: *the purpose of the United Way is to maintain the high quality of life in the St. Paul area; and*

WHEREAS: *over 18,000 volunteers are involved in the United Way effort; and*

WHEREAS: *over 175,000 of our citizens depended on United Way agencies for help and guidance last year; and*

WHEREAS: *over 70 agencies and services rely on the United Way for support; and*

WHEREAS: *the goal for the 1977 United Way campaign is 8.3 million dollars;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the months of September and October, 1977 to be

UNITED WAY MONTHS

in Minnesota, and I urge the citizens of the St. Paul area to cooperate to the fullest with the St. Paul United Way in undertaking whatever projects of goodwill that will lay the foundations for making the St. Paul area A BETTER PLACE TO LIVE.
