



Proclamation

WHEREAS: on October 31, 1977, the UNITED NATIONS CHILDREN'S FUND - UNICEF - will celebrate its years of devoted service to the children of the world; and

WHEREAS: UNICEF is an international organization which helps extend health, nutrition, and educational services to the deprived children of over 100 countries in Asia, Africa, and Latin America; and

WHEREAS: the major concern of UNICEF is with the overall well-being of children and, since children do not live alone, many UNICEF programs touch the entire family and community as well as the child; and

WHEREAS: in recognition of the many problems in the world that UNICEF helps combat through the provision of supplies, equipment and program assistance; and

WHEREAS: UNICEF activities at Halloween help further this vital work with children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 31, 1977 to be

UNICEF DAY

in Minnesota, and call upon all our citizens to join with me in honoring the UNITED NATIONS CHILDREN'S FUND for the exceptional contributions it has made to the children of the world.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-seven and of the State the one hundred twentieth.
