ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CLEARBROOK TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ADJACENT TO THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, certain petitions dated August 23, 1977, signed by William A. Smith and Sharon E. Smith as to one parcel of land, Gary E. Luczak and Robert J. Luczak as to another parcel, and James Roland Jacobson and Donna Lee Jacobson as to another parcel, all requesting annexation of their lands hereinafter described, were duly presented to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in each petition and bounded and described in approximately one-third acre of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, each petition was signed by all the owners; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Leen Township has waived any objection to each of these proposed annexations and the City Council of Clearbrook knows of no party that would object to said annexations; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petitions abuts upon the city limits of the west boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARBROOK, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West, of the Fifth P.M., described as follows: Commencing at a point on the north line of Fourth Street, if extended, a distance of 60 feet west of the southwest corner of Lot 3, Block 2, Ashra's Fourth Addition, (said point also being on the west line of West Street); thence westerly along the north line of Fourth Street extended a distance of 100 feet; thence north and parallel with the west line of West Street a distance of 140 feet; thence east and parallel with the north line of Fourth Street extended a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to the west line of West Street; thence south a distance of 140 feet, more or less, along the west line of West Street to the point of beginning.

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West, of the Fifth P.M., described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the north line of Second Street 20 feet west of the southeast corner of Lot 6, Block 2, Aurora's Second Addition, thence westerly along the north line of Second Street a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing westerly along the north line of Second Street a distance of 100 feet; thence north along the east line of West Street, if extended, a distance of 155 feet; thence east and parallel with the north line of Second Street a distance of 100 feet; thence south a distance of 150 feet to the point of beginning.

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West, of the Fifth P.M. described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the north line of Third Street if extended 60 feet west of the southeast corner of Lot 8, Block 1, Aurora's Fourth Addition (said point also being on the west line of West Street); thence westerly along the north line of Third Street extended a distance of 100 feet; thence north and parallel with the west line of West Street a distance of 134.5 feet; thence east and parallel with the north line of Third Street extended a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to the west line of West Street; thence south a distance of 134.5 feet, more or less, along the west line of West Street to the point of beginning.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commissioner, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.



WHEREAS, certain petitions dated August 23, 1977, signed by William N. Smith and Sharon E. Smith as to one parcel of land, Gary F. Luczak and Judith A. Luczak as to another parcel and James Leland Jacobson and Donna Rae Jacobson as to another parcel, all requesting annexation of their lands hereinafter described, were duly presented to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in each petition and bounded and described is approximately one-third acre of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, each petition was signed by all the owners; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Leon Township has waived any objection to each of these proposed annexations and the City Council of Clearbrook knows of no party that would object to said annexations; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petitions abuts upon the city limits of the west boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEARBROOK, MINNESOTA,

Commencing at a point on the north line of Second Street 20 feet west of the southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 2, Aakre's Second Addition, thence westerly along the north line of Second Street a distance of 200 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing westerly along the north line of Second Street a distance of 100 feet; thence north along the east line of West Street, if extended, a distance of 150 feet; thence east and parallel with the north line of Second Street a distance of 100 feet; thence south a distance of 150 feet to the point of beginning.

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) West, of the Fifth P.M. described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the north line of Third Street if extended 60 feet west of the southwest corner of Lot 8, block 1, Aakre's Fourth Addition (said point also being on the west line of West Street); thence westerly along the north line of Third Street extended a distance of 100 feet; thence north and parallel with the west line of West Street a distance of 134.5 feet; thence east and parallel with the north line of Third Street extended a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to the west line of West Street; thence south a distance of 134.5 feet, more or less, along the west line of West Street to the point of beginning.

(3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the cities of Clearbrook and Gonvick in the County of Clearwater and it has its known office of issue in the city of Gonvick in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of the newspaper and business related thereto. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the managing officer and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
