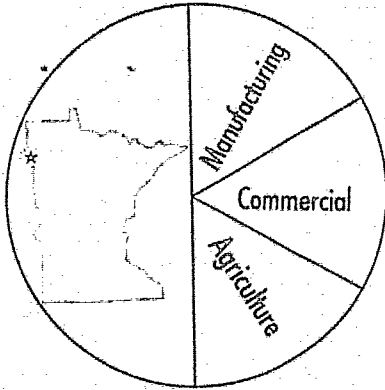

Ordinance No. 136-2nd Series

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EAST GRAND FORKS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW ¼) OF SECTION THIRTY-FIVE (35), TOWNSHIP ONEHUNDRED FIFTY-TWO (152) NORTH, RANGE FIFTY (50) WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, POLK COUNTY, MINNESOTA, NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES, WHICH TRACT CONTAINS 20.3436 ACRES.

The City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, do ordain:

Section 1. A Petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, by Edwin M. Wurden and Gladys L. Wurden, husband and wife; and Walter J. Mikkelson and Darlene D. Mikkelson, husband and wife; John J. Gaddie and Annabelle Gaddie, husband and wife; and Dean R. Gleason and Patricia Gleason, husband and wife, being all of the owners of the land hereinafter described, to have such land included within the City limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota; that copies of said Petition were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of Grand Forks Township and the County Board of Polk County, Minnesota; that more than 60 days have elapsed since such filings of said petition, and that no objections have been filed as is more fully shown by the records and files herein.

Section 2. That the tract of land being annexed is described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Northwest ¼ of Section 35, Township 152 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 35, Township 152 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian and thence proceeding easterly along the north boundary of said Section 35, for a distance of 380.00 feet to the true point of beginning; thence proceeding southerly parallel to the west boundary of said Section 35, for a distance of 1297.37 feet to the north boundary of Harney Addition to the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota; thence proceeding easterly along the said north boundary of said Harney Addition, for a distance of 872.04 feet to a point lying 40.00 feet distant westerly from the northeast corner of said Addition, said point being also the southwest corner of Wurden's 6th Addition to the City of East Grand Forks; thence proceeding North 0°02'15" West along the westernmost boundary of said Wurden's 6th Addition, for a distance of 340.00 feet; thence proceeding South 89°05'45" West, for a distance of 260.00 feet; thence proceeding North 0°02'15" West, for a distance of 958.09 feet to the north boundary of the aforesaid Section 35; thence proceeding westerly along the said north boundary of Section 35, for a distance of 618.16 feet to the true point of beginning said described tract comprised of 20.344 acres in the Northwest ¼ of Section 35, Township 152 North, Range 50 West of the 5th Principal Meridian.

Section 3. That the quantity of said land herein described is 20.3436 acres.

Section 4. That the City Council hereby determines:

1. That the quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is less than 200 acres.

2. That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

3. That the territory and land described as above abuts upon the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, is suitably conditioned for municipal government and is urban in character.

4. That the Petition for annexation was signed by all of the owners of the land and real estate hereinabove described.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 2., and the same is hereby annexed to and include in the City of East Grand Forks, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the State of Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, the Town Clerk, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section 7. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication, and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6, and be given the number 136-2nd Series.
