ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAKE WILSON, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated April 25, 1977, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 4th day of May, 1977; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 1.82 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by owner of said property and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation of said land are now filed with the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the south and east boundary thereof;

The council of the City of Lake Wilson, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the city and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character, and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it has originally been a part thereof:

A parcel of land located in Government Lot 1 of Section 13, Township 106 North, Range 43 West, Chanarambie Township, Murray County, Minnesota, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the North Quarter corner of said section; thence East, assumed bearing, along the north line of said section as platted in the original plat of Lake Wilson, a distance of 1417.10 feet; thence South a distance of 85.05 feet to the Point of Beginning of this description; said point also being on the south right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway 30 & 91; thence South 88 degrees 35 minutes 58 seconds East, along said right-of-way line, a distance of 212.37 feet; thence South 01 degrees 46 minutes 10 seconds West a distance of 370.92 feet; thence North 88 degrees 17 minutes 41 seconds West a distance of 200.95 feet; thence North a distance of 369.95 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Said parcel contains 1.82 acres of land, more or less, and is subject to existing easements of record.

Said property is located adjacent to the East boundary of Block Twelve (12), Original Plat of the City of Lake Wilson and adjacent to and South of State Highway #30.

Section 3. Filing. The city clerk is hereby directed to file

certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission,
The Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its
passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed
in Section 3.

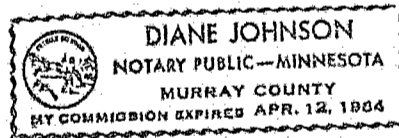
