WHEREAS: *total involvement of community and schools will maintain our high level of education in the state of Minnesota; and*


WHEREAS: *these concerns are reflected in the 1977 national theme -- WORKING TOGETHER FOR EDUCATION -- which suits Minnesota;*



AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK


