seizure prone to achieve control and function normally; and

WHEREAS: the educational program of the Minnesota Epilepsy League, under the guidance of

its parent organization, the Epilepsy Foundation of America, needs to increase public understanding of the disorder, develop concern for those who must live with these problems, and eliminate the ignorance that has surrounded epilepsy

for too many years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November, 1977 to be

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to become better acquainted with the general facts about epilepsy, and to encourage a more enlightened attitude about the disorder. The more you know about epilepsy, the more you want to help.
