



Alderman Ramberg addressed the City Council and tendered his resignation as a member of the Metropolitan Airports Commission, effective February 15, 1949.

Alderman Straiton and Alderman Bank moved that the Council accept the resignation of Alderman Ramberg from the Minneapolis-St. Paul Metropolitan Airports Commission effective Tuesday, February 15, 1949, and that Alderman Burgum be appointed to fill the unexpired term on the Metropolitan Airports Commission, and further, that Alderman Burgum's assignment to the License and Water Works Committees be transferred to Alderman Ramberg.

Alderman Todd moved to refer to the Committee on Committees with the request that one Alderman from the Twelfth Ward be appointed on the Metropolitan Airports Commission. Lost.

Question being on the original motion, it was adopted.
