WHEREAS: *Metal Buildings accounted for approximately one hundred twenty million dollars of construction in Minnesota during 1976; and*


WHEREAS: *the Northland Chapter of the Metal Building Dealers Association is one of the largest, strongest and most progressive chapters in the nation;*




METAL BUILDING WEEK
