WHEREAS: the Salvation Army, since its founding, has considered all men to be children of God, and has recognized no distinction of color, creed, or national origin among His sons; and


WHEREAS: one of the ways the Salvation Army raises funds for its many compassionate projects is through its "Kettle Campaign" during the Christmas season;



CHRISTMAS APPEAL DAYS


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to help the Salvation Army bell ringers fill the "Christmas Kettles", thus discovering the joy of sharing with a stranger.
