



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: agriculture is Minnesota's number one industry; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is one of the key food processing states in the nation; and

WHEREAS: schools serve more meals than any other organization in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: approximately 550,000 school children receive one-third of their daily nutritional requirements from this program; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's agricultural industry is an important source of a wide variety of high quality foods; and

WHEREAS: the school lunch program is an important market for Minnesota agriculture products;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week in January as

## ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL MINNESOTA SCHOOLS

and urge all schools of this state to participate in serving complete menus of food purchased and processed in Minnesota.
