WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees, a non-profit organization, are dedicated to the betterment of all mankind; and

WHEREAS: multiple sclerosis is a disease which strikes without warning, disabling young adults of Jaycee age; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has the second highest incidence rate of multiple sclerosis in the nation; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees have endorsed the Multiple Sclerosis Society as their Number One Priority Project for 1977-78; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Jaycees have united to help raise funds and promote public awareness of this disease, during the month of February, through the "Jaycees Strike for MS" Bowling and the "World's Largest Pancake Breakfast for MS";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1978 to be

JAYCEES VS MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS MONTH

in Minnesota, and call upon our citizens to join the Jaycees in aiding the Multiple Sclerosis cause.
