

Proclamation

WHEREAS: on February 19, 1978, the Minnesota Israel Philatelic Society is sponsoring an exposition known as MINIPEX 1978; and

WHEREAS: this is an exhibition of Israeli postal material to commemorate a number of events including the 5th anniversary of the Society as well as the 30th anniversary of the State of Israel; and

WHEREAS: it was in 1948 that Harry Truman, as President of the United States, recognized Israel as a State; and


WHEREAS: in honor of this event, MINIPEX 1978, is also producing a special postal souvenir: the United States commemorative stamp with President Harry Truman on an appropriate cover which will include a specially designed cancellation mark by the United States Postal Service;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, February 19, 1978 to be

MINIPEX 1978 DAY


in Minnesota, and ask all citizens to be aware of this significant observance.
