- AS: on December 30, 1977, Jim will celebrate his 40th birthday;


THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 30, 1977 to be




Minnesota, and join all his friends and admirers in wishing him a very happy birthday.
