WHEREAS: the contributions made by those concerned with Quality Assurance have stimulated similar motivation among other citizens in whatever vocations they may be engaged; and


WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota wishes to further promote the ideals of Quality Assurance as applied to all products for all consumers everywhere;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 5, 1978 to be

QUALITY ASSURANCE WEEK


