WHEREAS: the United States Army has for the past five years existed successfully in a no-draft environment; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has contributed significantly to the success of the all volunteer Army by the enlistment of her highly qualified young citizens; and

WHEREAS: those young Minnesotans have helped to create and maintain the most superior Army in its 203-year history;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February, 1978 to be

ARMY ENLISTMENT MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to pay tribute to the noble objectives of the United States Army Recruiting Command.
