

Proclamation


- WHEREAS: nurse anesthetists who serve in many of our Minnesota hospitals play an important role in providing efficient and modern health care to our citizens; and
- WHEREAS: more than fifty percent of all anesthesia today is administered by Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists; and
- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Association of Nurse Anesthetists encourages continuing education for Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists; and
- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Association of Nurse Anesthetists is affiliated with the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists which has a membership of more than 16,000; and
- WHEREAS: the Association has a growing concern for quality health care at a reasonable cost; and
- WHEREAS: the objective of the Association is to create an awareness of this profession within the health care team as well as to advance the science and art of anesthesia;


