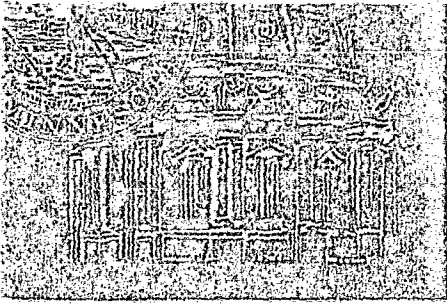




Proclamation

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota, 57 years ago, established the nation's first school safety patrol in St. Paul on February 17, 1921, and created a model for today's nationwide school safety patrol program; and

WHEREAS: these young school patrol workers have volunteered for positions of high responsibility and have contributed generously of their time to teach all school children to respect important traffic safety rules; and

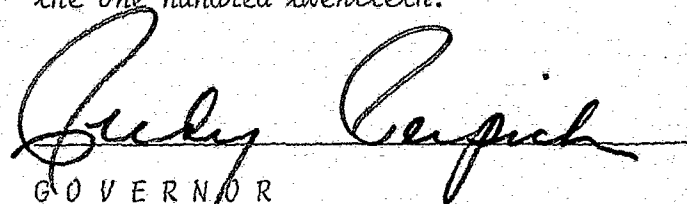
WHEREAS: the citizens of Minnesota annually express their gratitude to these young persons and honor them for valuable unselfish service;

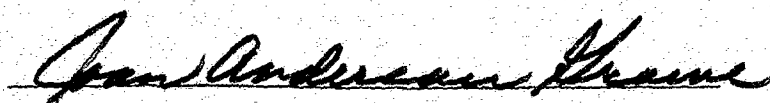

in Minnesota, and urge that all communities organize special programs to give due recognition to the young persons who so faithfully serve in the school safety patrol.

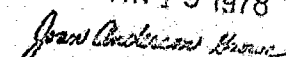
