

ORDINANCE NO. 366

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS  
OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA  
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, by the owner of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota:

A perpetual easement for road right-of-way purposes in and to the North 779 feet of the following described tract: A tract of land in the East One-half of the Southwest Quarter (E½ of SW¼) of Section 26, Township 139 North, Range 41 West of the 5th P. M., Becker County, Minnesota, to be dedicated to the City of Detroit Lakes as a public thoroughfare. The tract shall be 66 feet in width extending from the North line of Erickson-Benson Addition in the City of Detroit Lakes to the centerline of Trunk Highway #34, the centerline of which is described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of 11th Street S. E. and the North line of Erickson-Benson Addition in the City of Detroit Lakes; thence on and along the northward projection of the centerline of said 11th Street for a distance of 330.24 feet to a point of curvature with a curve that has a tangent of 139.24 feet, interior angle of 29° 56' to the right, and a degree of curvature of 11°; thence continuing on this curve to a point of tangency and continuing on this tangent a distance of 3.9' more or less, to a point of curvature with a curve that has a degree of curvature of 11° to the left and with such an interior angle and length of curve to become tangent to a line that is parallel to and 33 feet West of the Easterly line of the Junior High School tract recorded in Book 219 of Deeds, Page 699, in the office of the County Recorder of said County; and thence on the Northerly projection of this line to the centerline of Trunk Highway 34 and there terminating.

Section 2. The City Council hereby determines that:

1. The annexation will be in the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
2. The territory described herein abuts upon the City of Detroit Lakes and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to the city government.
3. The area to be annexed consists of approximately 1.2 acres.

Section 3. Therefore, the Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to and included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the County Auditor, the Secretary of State, and the Clerk of the Town Board, and from and after its passage and publication.
