ORDINANCE NO. 368

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANDS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, by the owners of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota:

That part lying in the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 139 North, Range 41 West and the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 138, Range 41, described as follows:

Beginning at a point of intersection of the North line of Legion Road and the Easterly right-of-way line of the Minneapolis St. Paul and Sault Ste. Marie Railroad; thence Westerly along the North line of Legion Road to a point which is 1297 feet Westerly, more or less, from the East line of Section 33, Township 139 North, Range 41 West to the East right-of-way line of a Township road; thence North on the East right-of-way line of said Township road to a point that is 660 feet North of the South line of the Southeast One-quarter of Section 33, Township 139 North Range 41 West: thence West and Section 33, Township 139 North, Range 41 West; thence West and parallel to the South line of the Southeast One-quarter of said Section 33 to the West line of the said Southeast One-quarter of said Section 33; thence South on the West line of the said Southeast One-quarter of the said Section 33 to the South line of said Southeast One-quarter of said Section 33; thence East on the South line of said Southeast One-quarter of said Section 33 to the East might of your line of the Minnespelis St. Paul and South Sto. Menio right-of-way line of the Minneapolis St. Paul and Sault Ste. Marie Railroad; thence Northeasterly to the point of beginning; also, that part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 138, Range 41, described as follows: beginning 188.64' East of the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 138, Range 41; thence South parallel to the West line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, 268.92'; thence East parallel to the North line of the Northeast Quarter to the East right-of-way line of the Minneapolis St. Paul and Sault Ste. Marie Railroad; thence Northeasterly on said right-of-way to the North line of Section 4; thence Westerly on the North line to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The City Council hereby determines that:

- The annexation will be in the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
- The territory described herein abuts upon the City of Detroit Lakes and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to the city government.
- The area to be annexed consists of approximately 29.13 acres, 3 residences occupied by 12 people; and that the official population of the City of Detroit Lakes should include the additional 12 people.

Section 3. Therefore, the Council of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same hereby is annexed to and included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the County Auditor, the Secretary of State, and the Clerk of the Town Board, and from and after its passage and publication.
