AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING ANNEXATION

THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Eldon H. Nordang and Nancy J. Nordang, the sole owners of property described in this ordinance, have petitioned the City of Granite Falls for annexation of the described property to the City of Granite Falls, Minnesota.

That the described land is unplatted and abuts the incorporated land of the City of Granite Falls, Yellow Medicine County, State of Minnesota.

That the unplatted land does not exceed 200 acres.

That no part of this land is now included in a proceeding for incorporation, consolidation, or annexation now pending before the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and that this land does not border any other municipality, other than the City of Granite Falls, Minnesota.

That there has been a waiver of objection to this annexation petition and proceeding and to the time period required by law which must pass before the passage of this ordinance, said waiver having been legally, duly and appropriately filed with the proper authorities by the appropriate Township Board, said filing of said waiver satisfying the legal requirement that 60 days pass from the filing of the petition before passage of this ordinance, and that no other objections have been received or made to this annexation proceeding.

(5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Granite Falls lying in the counties of Yellow Medicine and Chippewa and it has its known office of issue in the City of Granite Falls in Yellow Medicine County established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and devoted exclusively during such regular business hours to the business of the newspaper and business related thereto.
(6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society.
(7) Said newspaper is made available at single or subscription prices to any person, corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the newspaper and making the applicable payment.
(8) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below.
