ORDINANCE NO. 17, SECOND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ST. PETER 38 ACRES OF LAND LOCATED IN TRAVERSE TOWNSHIP, NICOLLET COUNTY, SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 110 NORTH, RANGE 26 WEST.

The City Council of the City of St. Peter ordains:

Section 1: A petition for annexation has been filed with the governing body of the City of St. Peter, Minnesota, by all of the owners of the land, petitioning the following described real estate to be annexed to the City of St. Peter, Minnesota, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE% of SE%) of Section No. Eight (8) in Township No. 110 North of Range No. 26 West, in Nicollet County, Minnesota, EXCEPTING THEREFROM the following described tract of land sold to Fred A. York, et al and described as follows: Commencing at a point on the North line of the S.E. % of the S.E. % of Section No. 8 in Township No. 110 North of Range 26 West, where the same is intersected by the Westerly right-of-way line of the County Road located and established along the east line of said S.E. ½ of the S.E. ½; thence southerly, and along said right-of-way line, a distance of 290.4 feet; thence West and parallel to the North line of said SE_{k} of the SE%, a distance of 300 feet; thence North, and parallel to said right-of-way line, a distance of 290.4 feet, more or less, to the North line of said S.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 thence East, and along said North line to the place of commencement.

Section 2: The area petitioned for annexation is unplatted.

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Section 3: An affidavit has been filed in the Office of the City Clerk stating that copies of the Petition for Annexation have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of Traverse Township and the County Board of Nicollet County, in which all of the land to be annexed is located, along with a Waiver by the Town Board of Traverse Township of the 60-Day Waiting Period as allowed by Rule 11 of the Minnesota Municipal Commission Rules.

Section 4: The annexation is in the best interests of the City.

Section 5: The corporate limits of the City of St. Peter, Minnesota, is hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6: The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, the Nicollet County Auditor, and the Traverse Township Clerk.


