WHEREAS: individual career goals and economic growth of the state are enhanced by training programs in occupational areas being demanded by business, industry and labor; and


WHEREAS: the American Vocational Association has designated the second week of February as "Vocational Education Week" and is supported by Minnesota vocational organizations in this endeavor;



## NATIONAL VOCATIONAL EDUCATION WEEK


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to become aware of the services and opportunities available through Minnesota vocational-technical education.
