
WHEREAS: four FFA chapters earned national championships in agricultural activities at the 50th National FFA Convention;



FFA WEEK


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be cognizant of the many contributions made to our state by the FFA'ers and to encourage the further development growth of this vocational student organization.
