WHEREAS: polka lovers of the State of Minnesota should have a time to celebrate, dance and listen to their favorite polka bands; and


WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota will host the world's largest polka festival at the Bel-Rae Ballroom on June 16, 17 and 18, 1978;



STATE POLKA FEST DAYS


in Minnesota.
