
WHEREAS: the engineering profession is already leading the way toward a variety of near-term and long-term solutions to these challenges;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 19, 1978 to be


ENGINEER'S WEEK
