WHEREAS: the health of all Americans depends upon educated minds and trained hands; and

WHEREAS: the practice of modern medicine at the life conserving standards we now enjoy would be impossible without the scientific tests performed daily in the Medical Laboratory; and

WHEREAS: the maintenance of these standards and progress towards improvement in the quality of laboratory services depends on the dedicated efforts of professional practitioners of Laboratory Science; and

WHEREAS: through this dedication, the Medical Laboratories of the United States have made a vital contribution to the quality of patient care;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 9 through April 15, 1978 to be

MEDICAL LABORATORY WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and support the vital service provided by the Medical Laboratory for the benefit of all citizens.
