ORDINANCE NO. 178

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN LAND CONTIGUOUS AND ABUTTING ON THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF FOSSTON, IN THE COUNTY OF POLK, STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO BE A PART OF SAID VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, All the owners of the tract of land hereinafter described abutting upon the Village of Fosston in the County of Polk and State of Minnesota, a municipal corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota and having less than 10,000 inhabitants have petitioned the Village Council of the Village to have said tract of land annexed to the Village, and to have said Council by ordinance declare said tract of land annexed to the Village to the end that such territory shall become a part of the Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof all in accordance with Section 412.041 of the Minnesota Statutes,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FOSSTON IN THE COUNTY OF POLK AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. The tract of land situated in the County of Polk and State of Minnesota abutting upon the Village and described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$) and Government Lot Two (2) in Section Four (4), Township One Hundred Forty-seven (147) North of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at a point 639.2 ft. North of the Center of said Section 4 on the North-South Quarter line of said Section; thence East parallel with the East-West Quarter Line of said Section a distance of 964.1 ft., more or less, to the westerly edge of that certain tract owned by the Village of Fosston, Minnesota, and described in a deed recorded in Book 210 of Deeds on page 474 in the office of the Register of Deeds for Polk County, Minnesota; thence North along the West edge of said tract owned by the Village of Fosston to the Northwest corner thereof; thence East along the North edge of said tract owned by the Village of Fosston a distance of 350 ft., more or less, to the Northeast Corner of said tract owned by the Village of Fosston; thence North and parallel with the North-South Quarter line of said Section to the North line of the South Half of the Northeast Quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 4; thence due East to a point on the North line of said South Half of the Northeast Quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$) of

said Section 4 which is due North of the Northwest Corner of Vigs Addition to the Village of Fosston, Minnesota; thence South to the Northwest Corner of said Vigs Addition; thence East along the North edge of said Vigs Addition a distance of 182.5 ft.; thence at right angles in a Northerly direction and parallel with Granum Avenue a distance of 211.7 ft.; thence at right angles in a Westerly direction and parallel with the Northerly line of Vigs Addition for a distance of 500 ft.; thence at right angles in a Northerly direction and parallel with Granum Avenue a distance of 388.3 ft.; thence West and parallel with the East-West Quarter line of said Section to a point on the North-South Quarter line of said Section; thence South along said North-South Quarter line to the place of commencement; tract containing 42 acres, more or less,

is hereby declared to be annexed to said Village of Fosston, which territory hereby becomes a part of said Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2. That the Village Clerk be and is hereby directed forthwith upon passage, publication and recording of the Ordinance, to cause a certified copy thereof to be recorded and filed in the Office of the Register of Deeds of said County of Polk, with the Clerk of the Township of Rosebud, Polk County, Minnesota, with the Minnesota Municipal Commission and with the Secretary of State.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, publication and recording.
