ORDINANCE NO. 1869  
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING  
TO THE CITY OF ROCHESTER  
CERTAIN PROPERTY COM-  
PLETELY SURROUNDED BY  
THE CITY OF ROCHESTER  
LYING BETWEEN PARKIN'S  
SUBDIVISION AND LOTS 106  
THROUGH 116, INCLUSIVE,  
BELMONT ADDITION.  
THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF ROCHESTER DO OR-  
DAIN:  
Section 1. Pursuant to the pro-  
visions of Minnesota Statutes,  
§414.033, subd. 4, the following de-  
scribed property which is complete-  
ly surrounded by land within the  
municipal limits of the City of  
Rochester, is hereby annexed, ad-  
ded to and made a part of the City of  
Rochester, Minnesota, as effectual-  
ly as if it had originally been a part  
thereof:  
The strip of land lying between  
the east line of Parkin's Sub-  
division and the west line of Lot  
106 to Lot 116, inclusive, Bel-  
mont, an addition to the City of  
Rochester, according to the plats  
thereof on file and of record in  
the office of the County Recorder  
of Olmsted County.  
Section 2. This ordinance is adopt-  
ed in order to annex property inad-  
vertently omitted from annexation  
by previous ordinances, including  
but not limited to Ordinance No. 841.  
Section 3. This ordinance shall  
take effect and be in force from and  
after its official publication and  
from and after the filing of a  
certified copy hereof with the Min-  
nesota Municipal Commission, the  
Rochester Town Clerk, the County  
Auditor and the Secretary of State.

November, 1976.
