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AN AMENDED ORDINANCE EXTENDING AND INCREASING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABIN, COUNTY OF CLAY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES 414,055, 572 ANNEXING

THERETO A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND CONTIGUOUS TO AND NOT EMBRACED WITHIN THE PRESENT LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABIN.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS a Petition was filed with the City of Sabin for the annexation of the below-described real property on January 4, 1977 and said Petition was signed by the sole owner of the below-described real property requesting annexation of his property to the City of Sabin; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sabin did annex the below-described real property to the City of Sabin pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 414.033 on March 8, 1977; and

WHEREAS, the legal description for the below-described real property, as set forth in said annexation ordinance filed for record in the office of the Clay County Recorder at Microfilm No. 334 983 contained a scrivener's error; and

WHEREAS, an Amended Petition in writing has been presented to the City Council of the City of Sabin requesting that an Amended Ordinance annexing the below-described property to the City of Sabin be adopted;

The City Council of the City of Sabin does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE

The City Council hereby determines that the Amended Petition was signed by the sole owner of the real property as of March 8, 1977, the date of the ordinance referenced above, as shown by the last assessment of such property and as would be subject to taxation by the City of Sabin in the event of annexation, within the tract described as follows:

SECTION FOUR

Upon the filing, posting and publication of copies of this Amended Ordinance as described in Section Three the annexation of the tract described in Section One shall be final.

SECTION FIVE

If any provision of this Amended Ordinance shall be held invalid, its invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this Amended Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision, and for this purpose the provisions of this Amended Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
