
WHEREAS: growth in an individual's level of self-sufficiency favorably affects the social and economic climate in the State of Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, March 15, 1978 to be

REHABILITATION DAY


