WHEREAS: the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences is a professional honorary organization composed of more than 4,000 motion picture craftsmen and artists and is the most prestigious film-related professional organization in the world; and

WHEREAS: the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences will celebrate the 50th anniversary of its annual Academy Awards presentation, more popularly known as the Oscar show, on April 3, 1978; and

WHEREAS: the awarding of Oscars by the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences has contributed greatly towards the artistic and technological excellence achieved by the motion picture industry over the past 50 years; and

WHEREAS: the motion picture is an important means of providing information, education and entertainment to the citizens of the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, April 3, 1978 to be
