WHEREAS: there is a definite need for further education in agriculture and agriculture related fields to insure the future development of its people and economic growth; and


WHEREAS: E.A.R.T.H. is making a continuous contribution to our post-secondary agriculture and agriculture related fields in education;



E.A.R.T.H. WEEK


