## RESOLUTION Canvassing Election and Announcing Results

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Caledonia, Minnesota, that it is hereby found and determined that at the special election held in the City on February 14, 1978, to vote on the following question:

> Currently the City operates and intends to continue to operate a municipal liquor store. Shall the City of Caledonia, in addition, be authorized to issue private "On Sale" liquor licenses to hotels and restaurants as defined in Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.07?

there were 295 votes in favor of the proposition, 254 votes against the proposition, and no ballots were illegible, spoiled or otherwise defective and the proposition is hereby declared carried by more than the required majority vote.
