

Proclamation.

WHEREAS: there are more than 7,100 children in the State of Minnesota who are living in foster homes due in part to overwhelming emotional or physical illness, alcoholism, poor

housing, inadequate income, drug addiction, or family break-up; and

WHEREAS: every child has a right to know love and have security in a stable family environment;

and

WHEREAS: the goal of good foster-family service is to improve home conditions so that the child

can return to his family or, if this is not possible, to find a suitable adoptive home

for him; and

WHEREAS: to have good foster-family services requires an adequate number of skilled social

workers, good foster homes, and community services; and

WHEREAS: foster children need the citizens of the State of Minnesota to be concerned with their problems, to vote for laws to protect them, to support services for them, and to be

involved in improving community foster-family programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1978 to be

ACTION FOR FOSTER CHILDREN MONTH

in Minnesota, and wrge all citizens to be aware and sensitive to the needs of foster children.
