WHEREAS: the Minnesota Society for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc. (MISCCA) has been serving the needs of Minnesota's physically handicapped through a wide range of programs in the fifty years since its founding; and

WHEREAS: the courage exhibited by the handicapped is a constant source of inspiration to their fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS: MISCCA operates one of the most outstanding residential camping programs for the handicapped in the nation through Camp Courage and Courage-North; and

WHEREAS: a dream came true for the handicapped of Minnesota through the establishment in 1973 of Courage Centre in Golden Valley; and

WHEREAS: due to the success of Courage Centre and all of the Courage programs, MISCCA, on its 50th anniversary, is officially changing its title at its annual meeting on Saturday, April 29, 1978 to Courage Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 23 through April 29, 1978 to be

COURAGE WEEK

in Minnesota.
