WHEREAS: *it is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries;*


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 29, 1978 to be


*in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and appreciate the safeguards to our liberty provided by our government of laws and by the orderly process of our courts.*
