WHEREAS: Ms. Eiden will compete as "National Secretary of the Year" in July at Dearborn, Michigan and


WHEREAS: this talented woman has represented her profession well with dedication, integrity and skill;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, April 16, 1978 to be


in Minnesota, and join the members of the Minnesota Association of Educational Office Personnel and her friends in wishing her continued success.
