



# Proclamation

- WHEREAS: the Roseville Community Band sponsored by the Roseville Parks and Recreation Department was established in the spring of 1962; and
- WHEREAS: the Roseville Community Band provides an opportunity for the adult musician to play for personal satisfaction and provides a service to the community through its concert schedule in the Central Park of Roseville, at other communities, at nearby senior citizens residences and Rosedale Center; and
- WHEREAS: the Roseville Community Band will be featured this year at the Minnesota State Fair and with the Minnesota Symphony Orchestra; and
- WHEREAS: the Roseville Community Band is rapidly establishing itself as the top community band in the upper midwest, requiring no auditions and having open membership; and
- WHEREAS: the Roseville Community Band has been singularly honored by an invitation from the Lord Mayor of Dublin, Michael Collins, to participate in the International Music Festival in June, 1979; and
- WHEREAS: the Roseville Community Band is the first adult community band from the United States to be invited to this prestigious event;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the opening day of the new concert season, May 7, 1978 to be

in Minnesota.

FURTHERMORE, I DO HEREBY appoint the Roseville Community Band as the official representative of the State of Minnesota to the International Music Festival in Dublin, Ireland in June, 1979.
