

Proclamation

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has received very favorable publicity due to the filming of "Ice Castles", a Columbia Pictures production currently on location here; and

WHEREAS: "Ice Castles" depicts the quality of life and of recreational facilities in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: because Minnesota was chosen as an ideal site for the production of "Ice Castles", more revenue has been brought into this state thus enriching the economy; and

WHEREAS: Americans will be informed of the beauty of Minnesota during the winter season when the film is publicized and released next December; and

WHEREAS: many Minnesotans were attracted to assist as "extras" during the shooting of a key crowd scene by the presence of such Hollywood stars as Robby Benson, Lynn-Holly Johnson, Colleen Dewhurst, Tom Skerritt, Jennifer Warren and David Huffman; and


WHEREAS: Columbia Pictures is making a sizeable donation to the Hubert H. Humphrey Institute of Public Affairs in lieu of payment to the volunteer "extras";


