WHEREAS: many young men and women of this state are members of both Junior and Senior ROTC programs; and

WHEREAS: ROTC detachments provide both excellent training and experience in leadership and management and create a sense of service to country; and

WHEREAS: ROTC graduates from the State of Minnesota have served with dedication and distinction as members of the Armed Forces and later, as leaders in the professional community and their communities at large;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 6, 1978 to be

ROTC DAY

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to be mindful of the service, dedication and purpose of ROTC in the defense of our country.
