WHEREAS: Buckminster Fuller is currently a World Fellow in Residence for a consortium of five eastern universities; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Fuller holds 39 honorary degrees, has published eighteen books and holds 818 patents in 55 countries; and

WHEREAS: renowned throughout the world, Buckminster Fuller is a foremost thinker, inventor, engineer, architect, mathematician, philosopher, conservationist, geographer and futurist; and

WHEREAS: he maintains challenging ideas for a better unity within a global context concentrating on conserving energy and resources, eliminating starvation and war, and exalting humanity and its vast imagination; and

WHEREAS: Bucky Fuller is a person to listen to, learn from and be with at the University of Minnesota during the weekend of April 28 where he will be the key participant at a seminar sponsored by the Minnesota Futurists and the Social, Psychological and Philosophical Foundation of Education of the University Effective Learning Systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the weekend of April 28 through April 31, 1978 to be

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to attend what is sure to be a satisfying and stimulating weekend.
