WHEREAS: international students in the United States have long been recognized as serious and dedicated scholars who contribute greatly to America and their home countries with their knowledge acquired here; and

WHEREAS: it is also realized that even while the international students are being educated, they are invaluable resources in educating Americans about their respective cultures, heritage, and tradition; and

WHEREAS: a group of Hong Kong students in the Twin Cities accepts and welcomes the instructive role that international students can play and has accordingly planned a formal, weeklong program of lectures, photographic displays and other activities on the Minneapolis and St. Paul campuses of the University of Minnesota--all designed to highlight the many facets of life in Hong Kong; and

WHEREAS: all programs and activities will be free and open to the public for the social and intellectual benefit thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 3 through April 9, 1978 to be

HONG KONG WEEK

in Minnesota.
